

ROCKY MOUNTAIN REGIONAL

JUNE 5-7, 2014

Thanks for registering your car for the Rocky Mountain Regional in Loveland, CO. I just wanted to remind you of a few important items before you arrive in Loveland.

1. This is an indoor event and once the cars are in place on the judging field they cannot be removed until all judging is completed on Saturday June 7th. I anticipate this will occur about 4:00 p.m.
2. Gas tanks must register ¼ full or less and contain less than 5 gallons of fuel. Gas caps will be taped before entering the convention center, and batteries must be disconnected.
3. If trailering your car, **do not unload until after picking up your registration packet at the entrance of the Convention Center.**
4. **All operations checks will take place in the trailer offload area.**
5. If driving to the event, arrive in plenty of time for your engine to cool down for the cold start portion of your operations check. It may be pretty warm on June 6th.
6. You sent a copy of proof of in force liability insurance for your car when you registered on-line or by mail. When you pick up your registration packet **we will review** that insurance information and you will be asked to sign your "Green Sheet" (insurance verification) including Insurance Co. name, policy number, and expiration date. The **insurance card** issued by your insurance company is what we like to see. Many states require such a card to be in a vehicle licensed for the street.
7. All owners are required to sign the "HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE" on the "Green Sheet" before their car is allowed to enter the judging field. No awards are presented to cars without such clause being signed.
8. The Convention Center is large enough that there may be room for some cars entered in the Sportsman category to be displayed on the inside judging field. Preference will be given to 1953-1996 stock appearing cars, and then to later models. Remember, once inside, they stay inside. **You must email me before May 28th, if you would like to display your Sportsman entry inside. Space is limited so first come, first served.**
9. A wash rack will be available behind the convention center.
10. Contact your team leader to schedule your PV. Most PV's will occur on Thursday. Do not unload your car until confirming with the Team Leader the time he wants to conduct the PV. If the Team Leader schedules your PV for Friday or Saturday, you must park your Corvette in its designated position on the judging field inside the convention center.
